The words **in red** describe the **nouns**.

- The word **two** tells us **how many** kites Aman has.
- The word **juicy** describes the **taste** of the apples.
- The word **white** describes the **colour** of the cat.

Describing words tell us about persons, places, animals and things.

- **Examples:** happy girl | big house | thin rabbit | blue car

Describing words tell us the shape, size and colour of nouns.

- **Examples:** oval mirror | tall tree | green leaves

Describing words also tell us about the special qualities of nouns.

- **Examples:** warm soup | soft pillow | noisy parrot

Sometimes, they tell us how many persons, animals, birds or things are there.

- **Examples:** five books | four ducks | one orange | three chairs
