a. What is the purpose of Layers in Krita?

Answer: Layers help us draw and edit different parts of an image separately without affecting other parts.

b. Describe the process of using the Gradient Tool in Krita.

Answer: Select the **Gradient Tool**, choose the colours, then click and drag on the canvas to apply the gradient.

c. How do you duplicate a layer in Krita?

Answer: Select the layer, right-click on it, and choose **Duplicate Layer**.

d. What steps are involved in creating a new layer in Krita?

Answer: Click the **Layer** menu, choose **New Layer**, select the layer type, and click **OK**.

5. Application-based questions

a. Sameira can use **layers in Krita** by keeping the road background on one layer and the characters on separate layers. She can edit, move, resize, or apply effects to characters without changing the background. Layers make the work easier, more organised, and flexible because changes can be made separately.

b. Gunjan should use the **Freehand Selection Tool (or Polygonal Selection Tool) in Krita** to select the shirt and pants accurately. It helps in making precise selections around complex shapes. She can then change colours of selected areas separately without affecting the rest of the image. It saves time and provides better control over detailed designs.
