Ans 1. The syntax for using the list style type property is

`< UL style= " list style - type.value " >`

Ans 2. A description list is used to list formatting for defining terms on web page. It is also called a definition list

Ans3. We use padding to add space between the border and the contents of a cell. We can use spacing to increase the border size or distance between cells. Since the table contents are present in <TH> and < TD>, the padding property is declared for these two elements in the style tag.

Ans 4. The border property is used to define the border of a table.

border	width	Specifies the thickness of the border
	style	Specifies the type of border
	colour	Specifies the colour of all sides of the border
